## Service Tracks Film Usage, Reorders Film and Remotely Monitors Printer Performance at 22 Clinics to Save Time, Reduce Costs

Managing supplies for several film types and sizes at all locations created challenges, according to Aaron Hatcher, the practice's General Manager of Operations.

"It was time consuming to manage film inventory levels for each site. We had an excessive amount of film at some clinics, while other sites would run out of film and require us to courier film to their location," Hatcher explains. "This inefficient process created unnecessary expenses and additional staff time."

As a result, Hatcher elected to outsource management of the practice's laser imagers, supplies and maintenance to CARESTREAM Managed Print Solutions. "This service delivers a long list of benefits including use of automated ordering for better inventory control and reduced staff time on film-related activities. Hatcher added that the program was implemented across all sites within three weeks and he received regular updates on new printer installations. In some cases the service engineer can reset the printer and correct the problem. If onsite service is required Carestream notifies us and sends a technician to the clinic," Hatcher notes.

A private web portal provides notification of film usage, orders and invoicing for each location. The portal also provides data on printer operations and a history of maintenance and service information.
